#### January 27th

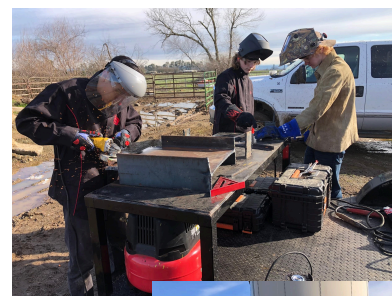

#### February 9th

Fabrication contests are an FFA Event where students compete to build a project in a certain time frame. Each contest is unique in its design, and the product students build. Students set up a work site, bring tools, develop a project that meets the guidelines, and work as a team to get it completed. Projects are judged on completeness, work quality, difficulty, and students are judged on safety and an interview. Our event focused on heavy steel construction.
