SCLH Garden Group is offering scholarship(s) for the 2024-2025 academic year as follows:

College, University	Full-time 12-15 units	\$1000
or Community College	Part-time 6-11 units	\$500

Forms must be completed, signed, dated and **postmarked by April 1, 2024.**

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be a California resident with a permanent home address in Lincoln, CA.
2. Must be a high school senior enrolled in a public school in Lincoln.
3. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher in order to apply.
4. Must be accepted and enrolled in a two or four year college or university.
5. Must be majoring in Horticulture, Floriculture, Landscape Design, Botany, Forestry, Conservation, Plant Pathology, Farm Management, Viticulture and Enology.
6. Photo of Applicant: If selected, applicant must provide a recent quality photo for publicity.

Application Requirements:

1. An **essay** of no more than two single spaced typed pages is required for all applications. State educational and personal goals including what experiences led you to choose your particular agricultural field of study. Please include community service and volunteer work as well as extracurricular activities with verification letters of participation.
2. Include **two letters of recommendation** from a teacher, counselor, professor or non-family related adult who can affirm your character and accomplishments. Statements from family members will not be accepted. Letters must be signed by the person including a phone number for verification.
3. You are required to attend the college or university indicated. **Enrollment verification will be required prior to fund distribution and by providing your college ID number.**

Distribution of Scholarship Funds:

Awarded funds will be mailed from the Garden Group to the Financial Aid Office of the institution at which the selected student(s) is enrolled. **No funds will be sent directly to the student(s).**

The student and the Financial Aid Officer will determine how the funds will be spent: tuition, books, etc. In the event of a change in a student's major to one other than those listed above, or if the student withdraws from school, the balance of the funds is to be returned to SCLH Garden Group. If a student's status changes from full-time to part-time, funds may be adjusted.
